

Why do children go to the chiropractor?

One study conducted in the United States, identified the 10 most common reasons why children went to the chiropractor. Those were as follows:

Earache.....	11.3%
Neck pain.....	10.6%
Check-up.....	10.3%
Headache.....	8.8%
Upper Respiratory.....	7.1%
Low back pain.....	6.3%
Allergies.....	4.5%
Asthma.....	3.3%
Enuresis (bedwetting).....	3.3%
Thoracic pain.....	3.2%

This list is 70% of the reasons that children see chiropractors. There are many other reasons why children would see a chiropractor. Among the other reasons are: torticollis, colic, insomnia, growing pain, and persistent crying in infants.

The normal function or physiology of the body are all controlled by the nervous system. When the bones of the spine are out of alignment (“subluxated”) this can cause interference with the nervous system.... which can affect the way our body functions.
